

COVID-19

Visitor & Resident Absence Policy – Effective June 18th, 2020

FOR VISITORS:

Prior to each visit, visitors must:

- Pass active screening every time they are on the premises or enter the building, and also attest that they are not experiencing any of the typical or atypical symptoms of COVID-19. The visitor's temperature will be taken prior to the visit, as well as after the visit has concluded. Visitors will not be allowed to visit if they do not pass the screening.
- Declare that they have tested **negative for COVID-19 within the previous 2 weeks** and subsequently not tested positive. (N.B. proof of a negative COVID test is recommended). Delmanor is not responsible for providing the testing.
- Comply with Delmanor's strict infection and prevention control protocols, including proper use of masks and hand sanitizing. Non-compliance with Delmanor's policies could result in the discontinuation of visits for the non-compliant visitor.
- Use a mask at **all times** when visiting. A **cloth mask** is acceptable for outdoor visits. A **surgical/procedure** mask is required as per Public Health, for indoor visits.
- Only **one (1) visitor** for indoor visits, and/or **two (2) visitors** from the same household for outdoor visits is permitted. Visitors are responsible for supplying their own cloth/surgical mask.
- Only visit the **one (1)** resident they are intending to visit, and no other resident(s). If a visitor wishes to see more than one resident, a separate visit must be scheduled.
- In order to visit, Delmanor must **NOT** be currently in an active outbreak. An outbreak is declared if **one (1)** resident OR team member tests positive for COVID-19. If an outbreak is declared, only essential visitors will be permitted.
- Visiting times and timeslots are limited and will be on a "first-reserved, first-served" basis. Approved areas for visitation will be designated at each Community for reservation.
- A team member will monitor visits to ensure PPE and physical distancing protocols are followed.

RESIDENT ABSENCES

Residents are permitted to leave Delmanor for short visits with friends/family, shopping, dental appointments, etc., provided the following requirements are met:

- Delmanor must NOT be in an active outbreak status. An outbreak is declared if **one (1)** resident OR team member tests positive for COVID-19. If an outbreak is declared, residents will only be permitted to leave the building for essential medical appointments.
- The short absence is limited to a maximum of 12 hours and cannot be overnight.
- Residents **must** wear a cloth or surgical mask while out in the community.
- Residents are required to maintain safe distancing of 6 feet whenever possible.
- Any non-adherence to these rules could be the basis for discontinuation of short absences.
- Residents must have their temperature taken prior to leaving the Community, and a second temperature check upon their return.
- Residents must sign in and out of the Community if they intend to leave the property.
